

## **Local Company's Scratch and Dent Sale to Benefit Charity**

And indeed the charity does hit home since New England Arbors employee Murray Sutherland has kidney disease and is a board member with a local branch of the kidney foundation. "Given my situation, the decision to support this charity is something that makes a personal connection," says Sutherland.

New England Arbors is the leading manufacturer of high end vinyl arbors, trellises, mail posts and address signs. They sell their products wholesale only to specialty retailers, mainly in the United States. Occasionally they get slightly defective material or product returns. The scratch and dent sale is an annual August event and is an opportunity for the general public to buy merchandise for incredibly low prices.
